Shivaji Arts and Commerce College Baad Karwar affiliated to Karnataka University Dharward, is one of the oldest higher education institutions in Uttara Kannada district of Karnataka state. With a modest beginning of the college in 1970 with a measure strength of 70 students in Arts, the college today has 275 students in Arts & Commerce sections. The newly added BCA stream (self financed) has 140 students. The college was established mainly to cater to the educational needs of socially and economically backward students of this area and since its establishment it has been striving towards achieving this purpose.

The institution has undergone two NAAC accreditations. In the first cycle i.e in February 2005, it has been awarded B+ grade (75.85 CGPA) and in the second cycle i.e April 2012, it has been awarded B grade (2.74 CGPA)
